

Creating the heart bottoms

You will need the (2) FQ A $3\frac{3}{4}$ inch x 7 rectangles and the (4) $3\frac{3}{4}$ inch background squares.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of all (4) background squares. This is your sewing line.

Align a square on the right side of the rectangles and sew on the line. **Press** open. Trim the excess fabric from behind.

Repeat for the left side of the rectangles. Set these aside. These are the bottoms of the hearts.

Creating the heart tops

You will need the (4) $3\frac{3}{4}$ inch squares from FQ A and the (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of FQ B.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares FQ B fabric. Place a square as shown on the inner corners of this heart top. Sew the square on the diagonal line and press open. Trim the excess fabric from behind. Now sew the two sides together. Press the seam **open**.
